



# Uniform Policy

Requirements as at 01/01/2024

## College Formal Uniform

- Short sleeve white College blouse (only white or skin coloured underwear to be worn.)
- Maroon cross-over tie. Year 12 students wear the striped Senior tie. (Provided to students at the end of Year 11)
- Maroon six (6) gored skirt (length just below the knee) or College maroon formal pants.
- Students may choose to wear the College pants as a replacement for the College skirt.
- Socks - plain white crew or SMC socks. No stripes, logos or embellishments. Ankle socks are not to be worn. Socks can be replaced by maroon tights in the winter period. Socks are not to be worn over tights.
- Shoes - polishable, black leather lace up shoes, school style - no Mary-janes or sneaker styles (these are to be kept clean and polished)
- College hats are compulsory for all students and must be worn to and from school, between classes and at break time. Hats must be clean and in good condition. Hats are not to be worn indoors.
- College maroon V-neck jumper can be worn with the uniform in winter and on cooler days during the summer period.
- The College blazer is compulsory during the winter period and for formal College events.
- Plain maroon scarves and gloves can be added in the winter period. No scarves are to be worn during the summer period.
- Long sleeve shirts of any kind are not permitted to be worn under the College blouse.
- The College bag is the only acceptable form of a school bag. (2 styles are available)
- The College Badge and House Badge must be pinned to the tie (Year 7 students will be presented their badge in the first week of school). Other non-school badges are not allowed. Replacement badges can be purchased via the QKR! App.





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## College Sports Uniform

The sports uniform is not to be worn to or from school. If students require their sports uniform in period 1 or 2, they will be allocated time at the start of the lesson to change and will be required to change out of their sport uniform at the next break.

- College blue polo shirt with maroon, blue and white striped collar,
- College maroon shorts.
- Clean sports joggers with non-marking soles and shoelaces. Canvas, street, skate and ankle high shoes, crocs, Birkenstocks, thongs, or any other similar style shoes are not permitted whilst wearing the College sport uniform.
- White sport crew socks. No ankle socks are permitted.
- College sport hat is to be worn for sport and HPE/PE.
- The College jumper may be worn with the sports uniform.
- The College tracksuit may be worn with the sports uniform on sports days. The tracksuit is not to be worn to and from school at any time or with the College formal uniform.
- Leggings and other additional items may not be worn with the sports uniform - Only SMC branded apparel may be worn.
- Squad t-shirts are not to be worn as part of the normal sport uniform - this also includes house shirts and jerseys etc.

## Jewellery

- One small gold or silver sleeper (up to 8mm) or studs which can include small stones or pearls (up to 3mm). This means ONLY one piercing in the lower lobe is allowed and a maximum of ONE retainer in the ear.
- Piercings in any other part of the body are not acceptable for school. No facial piercings, including tongue piercings are permitted.
- A plain coloured functional wristwatch is allowed. Smart watches are not to be connected to the internet throughout the school day or a student can be asked to hand it into the student office as per mobile phones.
- No additional jewellery is allowed, including rings, bracelets, anklets etc. A simple crucifix may be worn on a chain around the neck.





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## Make-Up

- A natural appearance is required.
- No coloured lip balm, tinted moisturisers or sunscreens, make-up, eyebrow pencil/ powder/ tinting/ tattooing, fake tan, false eyelashes/extensions, and coloured nail polish are not acceptable for students in College uniform.
- Tattoos are not permitted. This includes henna, temporary, and cosmetic tattooing.
- Nails - only short, natural nails may be worn. No colour is permitted including pink, brown/nude, beige, buff and nail art. No acrylic nails are to be worn at school; this is a Workplace Health and Safety and hygiene issue in many of their classes. False nails worn for College formals or socials must be removed after the event, and prior to the return to school.

## Hair

- Hair which falls on or below the shoulders it to be tied or pinned completely back.
- Only a small maroon, or white ribbon is allowed.
- Headbands up to 2.5cm are allowed in plain white or maroon - no patterns.
- Fringes which obscure vision are to be pinned back.
- Hair of one natural colour is acceptable - this does not include bright, two-tone colours and highlights.
- Undercuts and shaved/or partially shaved hair is not permitted.
- No claw clips.

## Contact Lenses

- Coloured contact lenses are not to be worn.

**If uniform items are not of an acceptable condition, they will need to be replaced.**
